

Regents' Test Exemption Guidelines for Graduation
For Students Who Were Last Enrolled Prior to Spring 2011

These guidelines are for students who were not currently enrolled or whose files are no longer active at Georgia Perimeter College as of Spring Semester 2011 and:

- Met all degree requirements except for passing one or both portions of the Regents' Test at the time of last enrollment.
- Passed ENGL 1101 and ENGL 1102 with a 'C' or better.

These students will need to:

- Review the current list of degree programs at <http://www.gpc.edu/programs/> to determine if the program of study is still offered and the current degree requirements.
- Submit an application for graduation along with the \$25.00 non-refundable application fee to the Enrollment and Registration Services office.

An official degree audit will be processed based on current catalog requirements for the program of study. The results of the degree audit will be sent to the email address indicated on the application for graduation.

- If any additional courses are required based on current catalog requirements, they must be completed before a degree can be awarded. If the student has transferred to another institution, up to nine semester hours of applicable courses may be transferred back to GPC to complete the degree.
- If all degree requirements have been met or additional courses completed, students will be awarded the degree for the current term.

Students will be eligible to walk in the next commencement ceremony. Spring Commencement for spring graduates or Fall Commencement for summer and fall graduates. However, based on the timing of the submission of the application for graduation, the students name may not appear in the printed commencement program.

If Georgia Perimeter College no longer offers the program of study:

- Review the current list of degree programs at <http://www.gpc.edu/programs/>.

It is possible that the courses the student has taken will meet the majority of requirements for another program or additional courses can be taken to meet the requirements for another program.

- If any additional courses are required based on current catalog requirements, they must be completed before a degree can be awarded. If the student has transferred to another institution, up to nine semester hours of applicable courses may be transferred back to GPC to complete the degree.
- Submit an application for graduation along with the \$25.00 non-refundable application fee to the Enrollment and Registration Services office by the deadline for the anticipated term of graduation.
